Your discussion should focus on the importance of knowing the Story of God so that it can guide us through the uncertainties of life.

Open - "I've never been this way before"

How is the economic situation affecting you?

What is the greatest concern you have about the uncertainty of it all?

Bible Discussion - Joshua 3 & 4

What is the point of the pile of rocks? See Joshua 4:4-7 & 21-24.

Talk about these words (Joshua 3:3b-4a), connecting them with the call to remember:

"When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests, who are Levites, carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it. Then you will know which way to go, since you have never been this way before."

Taking It Home

How does our communion serve as a reminder?

What does it remind you of? [You may want to revisit Hebrews 12:1-3.]

How does this help you navigate those places/times where "you have never been before"?

What is your greatest concern this evening? How can we pray for you?
