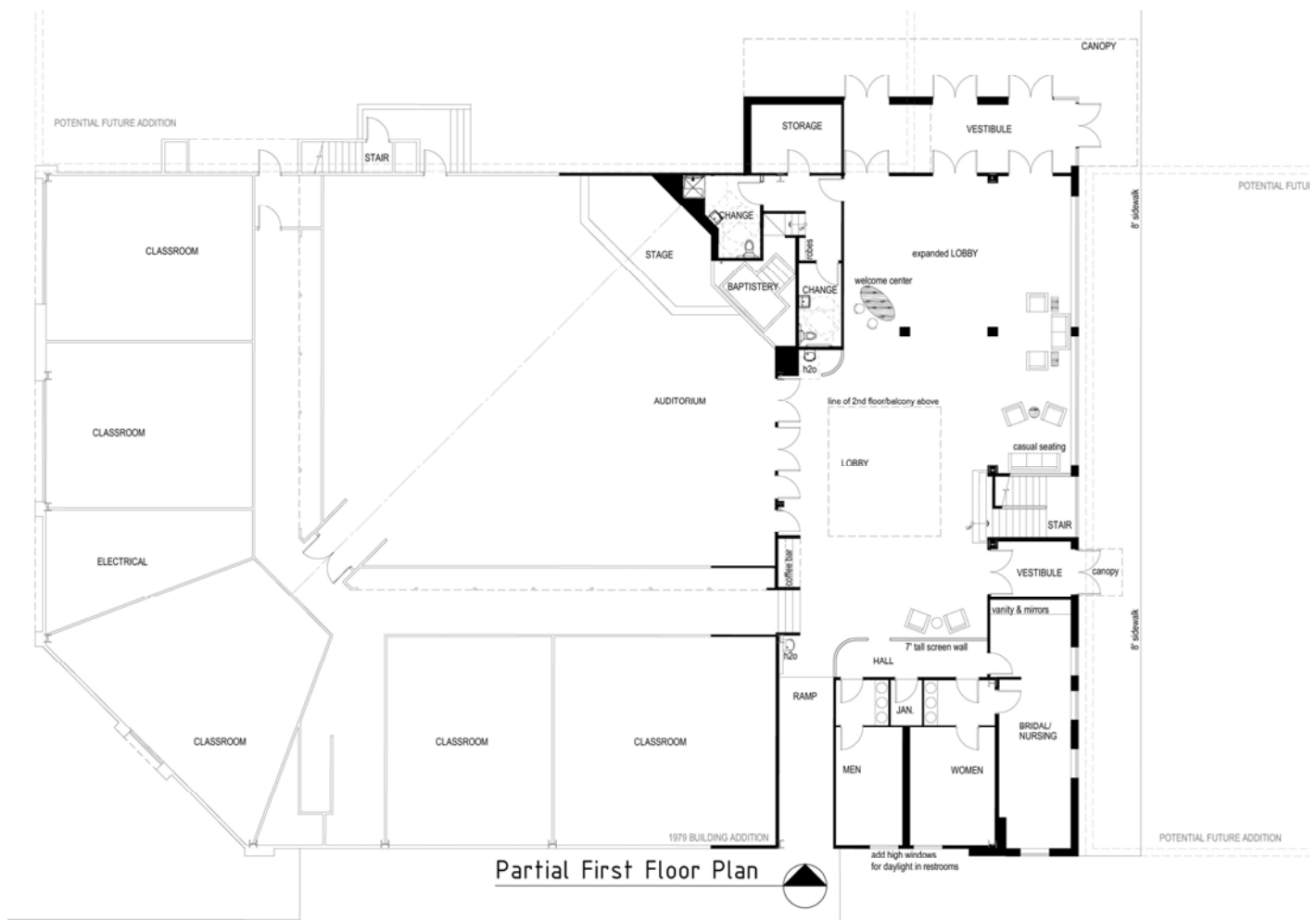




Focus of Design:

- ◆ Metal cladding on the outside of the building is showing signs of age and weather exposure. In many locations, the sheathing underneath is deteriorating and allowing damage to the interior of the building.
- ◆ Replacing the metal cladding with stucco and cultured stone not only addresses functional issues, but also provides for a more consistent and architecturally pleasing appearance.
- ◆ Relocating multiple doors on the north side provides a new focal point for the entrance off the main parking lot.
- ◆ Additional windows allow for natural light creating a more spacious feel in the lobby.
- ◆ A canopy offers covered drop off points on both the east and north side of the building.



Focus of Design:

- ◆ Restrictive, undersized lobby — *Open, welcoming space created by extending walls, bringing in more light, and removing awkward nooks and corners. Floor plan provides 40% more space.*
- ◆ Narrow north entrance — *Interior wall pushed back into the baptistery area offers multiple doors facing the primary parking lot. Plan allows for conversational seating area.*
- ◆ Lobby has open view to restrooms — *Screening provides greater privacy.*
- ◆ Baptistery has small changing rooms and inefficient storage — *Area reconfigured for larger changing rooms (one includes a shower) and added storage room.*
- ◆ Stained and worn carpet, cracked walls and ceiling — *Newly designed space involves repairs, paint, and new flooring.*
- ◆ *Design creates a bridal dressing/nursing room adjacent to the women’s restroom.*
- ◆ *North vestibule will connect to possible future additions (gym or additional meeting rooms).*
